



International licence: rule



• Athletes, coaches and officials who wish to participate in Championships, Games, International and National Tournaments, which are recognised or controlled by World Archery or a Member Association, in one or more of the various disciplines recognised by World Archery, shall be affiliated with a Member Association and have a valid international license (until such time that the Executive Board adopts bylaws as to international license requirements, an athlete's, coaches' and official's membership in his Member Association shall constitute a valid international license.)

International licence: approach



All registrations through WAREOS **need** a licence

All registrations through Open WAREOS **do not** need one



Questions asked




- 1. Will this license cover health insurance for the athletes and officials during all competitions in 2022?
- → No only tournaments where entries were done through WAREOS. So basically World Ranking tournaments, World Championships and Continental Championships
- 2. Can you specify which competition will need to have licence?
 - World Ranking tournaments (including EGP, Asian cup,...)
 - World Games
 - Continental Championships
- 3. Youth Events and Indoor Championships don't count towards World Ranking, do they need a license?
- → All registrations through WAREOS need a licence

Licence: general conditions



- **Cost:** 100 CHF per calendar year per athlete/official (it is linked to the person not per event)
- Includes: travel and health insurance
- A digital certificate of the licence will be available to download from IMSSA's platform



Licence: registration and invoicing



- Registration would be through the accreditation process at the first event
- Two possibilities for invoicing:
 - **1. Payment at the first event** the person participates, or
 - 2. Invoice at the end of the year like for calendar tournaments and membership fees
- Member associations must indicate their invoicing preference (first event / end of the year) by email to Cécile Tosetti (ctosetti@archery.sport)
- A federation cannot have a mix of the two systems / change the type of invoicing once the first payment is done



Licence: payment - option 1



Option 1: payment at the first competition the person participates

- a) MA can pay <u>in cash</u> on site at the first event at the registration booth
 - Price: **100 CHF** or
 - currency accepted 110 USD or
 - 100 EUR (updated 21.03.2022)
- b) Or may pay by <u>bank transfer</u> to WA before the start of the competition; invoice to be asked to ctosetti@archery.sport




Licence: payment - option 2



Option 2: payment at the end of the year – as for calendar, membership fees or e-learning codes





Insurance: services covered



Illness or accident


- outpatient care (doctors, medicines and tests)
- hospitalisation costs
- Pandemics such as COVID-19 (treated as illnesses)
- Disability or death following an accident:
 - the amount of services provided are subject to status and the level of cover
 - non-accidental deaths (e.g. due to cardiac arrest or stroke) are also covered, subject to status

Luggage and personal effects

- luggage delays
- delayed or cancelled flights (more than 4 hours)
- theft, damage or loss of luggage by the carrier
- Report any theft to the police and complete the online claim form



Insurance: claim

 - ID: WA
 - Password: 22A966567
- www.imssa.org makes it easy for you to submit a claim for reimbursement for:
 - Illness or accident
 - Lost, stolen or delayed luggage
 - Flight or trip cancellation (COVID-19)
- More information in IMSSA <u>Guidelines to make a claim</u>
- Reimbursement is always by bank transfer to the federation or to the affected person
- It takes maximum 30 days, provided that all information is submitted with the claim

- →No, licences are generated during the registration and accreditation process at the first event the person participates

- 4. If I register an athlete for the first time in an event in October 2022, is the license be valid until October 2023?
- → No, it is valid during a calendar year (01.01.22 31.12.22)
