What is ISF?

Founded in 1972, the **International School Sport Federation** (ISF) is an international non-profit sport organisation, acting as the umbrella organisation and governing body for national school sport organisations around the world, **organising sport**, **and educational events for youth from 6 to 18 years old**.

Recognised by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) since 1995, the ISF currently consists of **132 members** over the five continents organising **over 10 events per year and has more than 30 different sports included in its competition programme**.

What is a Gymnasiade?

- Multi-sport event
- Held over 7 days
- Sport competitions with social and educational programme
- Age categories depending on event:
 - U18 Gymnasiade: archers 16, 17 and 18 years old
 - U 15 Gymnasiade: archers 13, 14 and 15 years old

Why to consider Gymnasiade participation?

- Good for first experience at international level
- Cultural aspect of the event and value in participation
- Possible to advance early younger classes that in World Archery
- Possibility of making friends to add motivation in sport career
- Relatively low cost

Which categories?

Boys

- 1. Individual Recurve boys
- 2. Individual Compound boys
- 3. Recurve Boys Team
- 4. Compound Boys Team

Girls

- 1. Individual Recurve girls
- 2. Individual Compound girls
- 3. Recurve Girls Team Event
- 4. Compound Girls Team

Age Category:

2008 - 2009-2010

Mixed

- 1. Recurve mixed team event
- 2. Compound mixed team event



How many allowed per country?

In archery, each delegation can enter a maximum number of 16 participants divided as follows:

- 6 recurve archers 3 boys & 3 girls
- 6 compound archers 3 boys & 3 girls
- 4 coaches*

Coaches division*:

- from 1 to 3 athletes = 1 coach
- from 4 to 6 athletes = 2 coaches
- from 7 to 9 athletes = 3 coaches
- from 10 to 12 athletes = 4 coaches



Which rules will be used?

World Archery rules will apply, except the fact that usually U15 age category does not exist.

Currently, the rules for U18 are planned to be used in U15 event in 2023:

- Recurve 60m, 122cm target face
- Compound 50m, 80cm target face (6-10)

Note: there will be a survey sent out to collect data regarding what is done on national level. Based on that it might be considered to propose making the distance shorter already for 2023 Gymnasiade. It will be communicated latest in February newsletter.



Related costs

- Flight tickets
- **Participation fee:** 60€ / night / delegation member The participation fee covers full board accommodation (double room occupancy) for the duration of the event, cultural program activities and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the team.
- **ISF levy:** 50€ per delegation member
- **Insurance** (World Archery insurance does not cover it, these athletes do not need a licence)

Tip: It is worth checking with your national school sport federation to know if there is any financial support from them.



How to get registered?

Through your national school sport federation.

Deadlines (to be extended, probably)

15 February - preliminary

19 May 2023 - final

Important to know

ISF has no minimum score set for athletes.

Please keep in mind that there might be agreement between national archery federation and national school sport federation to determine the criteria for team members.
